



Brescia University College Students' Council Awards Criteria

The Margaret Wickware Award

- 1.0 Can be awarded to a maximum of two (2) students.
- 2.0 The students must be enrolled at Brescia University College.
- 3.0 Awarded to students deemed to have contributed the most in general to the school while maintaining a certain level of academic achievement.
 - 3.1 Must be in good standing with a minimum of a sixty-five percent (65%) grade average either cumulatively or in the last academic year, as certified by the Assoc. Registrar, Student Success
- 4.0 Applications will be open as determined by the BUCSC President.
 - 4.1 Applications will be processed using an online form outlining the students' contributions and involvement
 - 4.2 Selections will be made by the BUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 4.2.1 BUCSC Student Awards Committee will be determined and chaired by the President.
 - 4.2.2 No one on the BUCSC Student Awards Committee may apply or be the recipient of this award

The Tina Insanally Leadership Award

- 1.0 Can be awarded to a maximum of two (2) students.
- 2.0 The students must be enrolled at Brescia University College.
- 3.0 Awarded to the students who have demonstrated Brescia's spirit of leadership in their day- to-day life.
 - 2.1 This person does not have to have held formal leadership roles at Brescia, but is recognized to have shown positivity to all those around them.
- 4.0 Must be in good standing with a minimum of a sixty-five percent (65%) grade average either cumulatively or in the last academic year, as certified by the Assoc. Registrar, Student Success
- 5.0 Applications will be open as determined by the BUCSC President.
 - 5.1 Applications will be processed using an online form outlining the students' contributions and involvement
 5. 2 Selections will be made by the BUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 5.2.1 BUCSC Student Awards Committee will be determined and chaired by the President.
 - 5.2.2 No one on the BUCSC Student Awards Committee may apply or be the recipient of this award.

Ursuline Sisters Community Engagement Award

- 1.0 Can be awarded to a maximum of five (5) students.



- 2.0 The student(s) must be enrolled at Brescia University College.
- 3.0 Awarded to students who have made extracurricular contributions to the College, while maintaining a certain level of academic achievement.
 - 3.1 Recognizes students' outstanding contribution to the on and off campus communities
 - 3.2 Must demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities
 - 3.3 Must be in good standing with a minimum of a sixty-five percent (65%) grade average either cumulatively or in the last academic year, as certified by the Assoc. Registrar, Student Success
- 4.0 Applications will be open as determined by the BUCSC President.
 - 4.1 Applications will be processed using an online form outlining the students' contributions and involvement
 - 4.2 Selections will be made by the BUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 4.2.1 BUCSC Student Awards Committee will be determined and chaired by the President.
 - 4.2.2 No one on the BUCSC Student Awards Committee may apply or be the recipient of this award

Dr. Joan Francolini Memorial Award

- 1.0 Can be awarded to a maximum of four (4) students.
- 2.0 The students must be enrolled at Brescia University College.
- 3.0 Awarded to students who are highly involved outside of the Brescia community, while maintaining a certain level of academic achievement.



- 3.1 Must be in good standing with a minimum of a sixty-five percent (65%) grade average either cumulatively or in the last academic year, as certified by the Assoc. Registrar, Student Success
- 4.0 Recognizes students' outstanding contributions for their volunteerism, and service work in their greater communities—whether local, or global—as defined by the student.
- 5.0 Applications will be open as determined by the BUCSC President.
 - 5.1 Applications will be processed using an online form outlining the students' contributions and involvement
 - 5.2 Selections will be made by the BUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 5.2.1 BUCSC Student Awards Committee will be determined and chaired by the President.
 - 5.2.2 No one on the BUCSC Student Awards Committee may apply or be the recipient of this award.

The Shiloh Roberts Compassion Award

- 1.0 Can be awarded to a maximum of two (2) students.
- 2.0 The students must be enrolled as an international student at Brescia University College.
- 3.0 Awarded to students who have shown volunteerism, and service work at Brescia and/or in their greater communities—whether local, or global—as defined by the student.
 - 3.1 Must demonstrate genuine compassion in their day-to-day life
 - 3.2 This person does not have to have held formal leadership roles at Brescia, but is recognized to have shown positivity to those around them
- 4.0 Applications will be open as determined by the BUCSC President.
 - 4.1 Applications will be processed using an online form outlining the students' contributions and involvement
 - 4.2 Selections will be made by the BUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 4.2.1 BUCSC Student Awards Committee will be determined and chaired by the President.
 - 4.2.2 No one on the BUCSC Student Awards Committee may apply or be the recipient of this award
